



Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act allocated federal funds to be given directly to Title IV eligible students in the form of emergency relief grants. These funds are statutorily required to be used to cover expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus. Eligible expenses are those that qualify under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare and childcare. As a student of Tri-State Cosmetology Institute, you are eligible to receive an emergency grant through the CARES Act. This grant will be issued in the form of a paper check and mailed to the current mailing address we have on file for you.
